Missouri Press Foundation Newspaper Internship Program Summer 2017 -- APPLICATION FORM

Missouri Press Foundation (MPF) is offering Missouri newspapers the opportunity to host a summer intern for 4, 6 or 8 weeks. For a 4-week internship, the Foundation will send the newspaper \$500, a 6-week internship will receive \$750 and an 8-week internship will receive \$1,000. The newspaper uses these funds, *and its own*, to pay its summer intern. All grants are based upon a 40-hour work week for the intern. If another work schedule is implemented, the grant will be based upon the anticipated work schedule. Depending on funding to MPF, up to 10 summer internships will be approved. Internship application forms will be reviewed for approval by a committee of MPF members.

Interns eligible for this program must be students enrolled in an accredited post-secondary academic, professional, or vocational newspaper journalism program in Missouri. They may work as newspaper reporters, editors, photographers, designers, advertising representatives or web site editors/reporters, according to jobs being offered by the participating newspapers.

If your newspaper is interested in hosting an intern, please complete this application form and return it to MPF, 802 Locust St., Columbia, MO 65201. **Applications for the Internship Grants Program must be received on or before March 31.**

FOUNDATION GRANTS PROGRAM

The Missouri Press Foundation is continuing its Internship Grants Program to help train tomorrow's professionals by providing grants to support internships at Missouri Press Association member newspapers.

THE NEWSPAPER'S OBLIGATION

Newspapers on the accompanying list agree to host an intern.

Students may apply for internships of four weeks to eight weeks.

Newspapers will hire the interns and negotiate their wages.

SELECTING INTERNS

Interns eligible for this program must be students enrolled in an accredited post-secondary academic, professional, or vocational newspaper journalism program in Missouri. They may work as newspaper reporters, editors, photographers, designers, advertising representatives or web site editors/reporters, according to jobs being offered by the participating newspapers.

In addition to earning a salary, interns may receive institutional credit, if their schools allow it. Interns are responsible for arranging credit.

Newspapers are responsible for hiring the interns. Potential interns should contact the newspapers listed.

IMPORTANT: Identify yourself as seeking a Missouri Press Foundation summer internship.

This grants program is limited to interns attending a university, college or other training program in Missouri. Relatives of a selected newspaper's owners or employees are prohibited from benefiting from the MPF internship grants program.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS, RESTRICTIONS:

At the end of internships, **host newspapers and interns must complete an evaluation form** provided by the MPF, and submit it to MPF.
