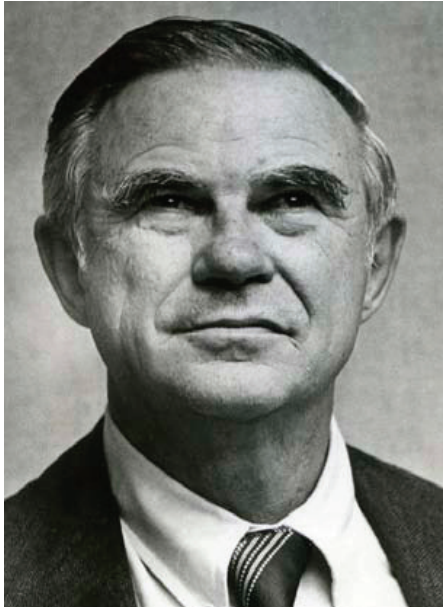

He kept his newspapers on the leading edge of new technology. He received the Honor Medal for Distinguished Service in Journalism from the Missouri School of Journalism, 1982. He founded St. Joseph Cablevision in 1965 and expanded the company's holdings to include television stations in Georgia, Mississippi, South Dakota and North Carolina. Active with the Associated Press, he served three terms as a director, 1970 to 1979. He and other AP directors made a goodwill visit to China in 1977. Former director, Inland Daily Press Association. Active in St. Joseph civic and business organizations, he insisted his newspapers take an active role in the community. He was president of the St. Joseph Industrial Development Corp., which established the industrial park at the east edge of the city.
