
## (1892-1980) William Aden (Bill) French



Publisher, The Current Wave, Eminence, 1937-1969. Also published the Winona Shannon County Democrat and the Birch Tree Shannon County Herald. Settled in Shannon County in 1905 from Tennessee. Was graduated in first class of Eminence High School, 1911. He became one of the Ozarks' most prolific writers with distinguished careers in journalism and education. His journals reveal a love of life in the Ozarks and a lifelong enthusiasm for hunting, fishing, farming and writing, from newspapers to novels. He wrote serial stories and four books. A St. Louis Post-Dispatch account noted French "wrote the novels, edited them, set them in type, proofread, printed and bound them, then promoted and published them." French taught school a few years, continued to write and mastered the printing trade. He reached that dream many newspapermen and women have sought, writing his Great American Novel. He recalled "the thrill that came to me when I saw one of my brain children displayed on the printed page with my name as author."
